You will create four LifePlans, being your personal life, family life, business, and Kingdom. These LifePlans each integrate your life story, calling statement and unique natural abilities, passion and energizing interests.

# My calling statement

A clear calling helps a person to be more pro-active and deliberate in focussing their life.

This incorporates your identity (being) and your destiny (doing).

I Samuel 3:3-9 and before the lamp of God went out in the tabernacle of the Lord where the ark of God was, and while Samuel was lying down, that the Lord called Samuel. And he answered, "Here I am!" So he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." And he said, "I did not call; lie down again." And he went and lay down. Then the Lord called yet again, "Samuel!" So Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." He answered, "I did not call, my son; lie down again." (Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord, nor was the word of the Lord yet revealed to him.) And the Lord called Samuel again the third time. So he arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you did call me." Then Eli perceived that the Lord had called the boy. Therefore Eli said to Samuel, "Go, lie down; and it shall be, if He calls you, that you must say, 'Speak, Lord, for Your servant hears.' "So Samuel went and lay down in his place.




